At **Lake Cumberland Regional Hospital**, we spent 2016 exploring ways to advance our mission of making the communities of south central Kentucky healthier. And by focusing our efforts on creating a place where people choose to come for healthcare, physicians want to practice and employees want to work, our more than 40 year legacy of caring for our communities is stronger than ever.

Inviting the best physicians into our communities and supporting them is one of the most important drivers of our ability to offer the best possible healthcare to the region. During the past year, Lake Cumberland added **nine new physicians**, including anesthesiologists, a cardiothoracic and vascular surgeon, hospitalists and a urologist.

And while **delivering high quality patient care close to home** is the single most important contribution we make, there are many other ways we're making a positive impact in our communities.

In **creating excellent workplaces for our 1,353 employees**, we made **\$2,938,947 in capital improvements** in 2016, including OR equipment upgrades, a urinalysis analyzer for our lab, new aortic balloon pumps and defibrillators throughout the facility; and we managed and distributed an **annual payroll of \$90,874,127**.

We are proud to take a **leadership role in our communities** and are committed to delivering needed healthcare to everyone, regardless of their ability to pay. In fact, in 2016 we donated **more than \$2.2 million in healthcare services to those in need**.

We are also committed to **ensuring fiscal responsibility** – both at the hospital and in the community. In 2016, we paid a total of **\$2,184,377 in taxes**, as well as provided numerous sponsorships and donations to local organizations.
