At **Ashley Regional Medical Center**,

we spent 2016 exploring ways to advance our mission of making the communities of Northeastern Utah healthier. By focusing our efforts on creating a place where people choose to come for healthcare, physicians want to practice and employees want to work, our legacy of caring for our communities in Uintah, Duchesne, Daggett and Rio Blanco counties is stronger than ever.

Inviting the best physicians into our communities and supporting them is one of the most important drivers of our ability to offer the best possible healthcare to the region. During the past year, Ashley Regional added **a new orthopedic surgeon** to our staff.

While **delivering high quality patient care close to home** is the single most important contribution we make, there are many other ways we're making a positive impact in our communities.

In **creating excellent workplaces for our 256 employees**, we made **\$2,698,335 in capital improvements** in 2016. These include a new arthroscopic tower and orthopedic power tools, new OR lights, main systems repair and pre-construction work on our \$35 million facility expansion and new women's center build. We also managed and distributed an **annual payroll of \$15,422,257**.

We are proud to take a **leadership role in our communities** and are committed to delivering needed healthcare to everyone, regardless of their ability to pay. In fact, in 2016 we donated **more than \$1.98 million in healthcare services to those in need**.

We are also committed to **ensuring fiscal responsibility** – both at the hospital and in the community. In 2016, we paid a total of **\$722,351 in taxes**, as well as provided numerous sponsorships and donations to local organizations.
