At **Bolivar Medical Center**, we spent 2016 exploring ways to advance our mission of making the communities of Cleveland and the surrounding area healthier. During the past year, Bolivar added **five new physicians** in obstetrics and gynecology, orthopedic surgery and pediatrics.

In **creating excellent workplaces for our 493 employees**, we made **\$2,350,973 in capital improvements** in 2016, including a new ultrasound unit, new lights in our ORs and orthopedic surgery equipment, and managed and distributed an **annual payroll of \$31,335,844**.

We are proud to take a **leadership role in our communities** and are committed to delivering needed healthcare to everyone, regardless of their ability to pay. In fact, in 2016 we donated **more than \$3.44 million in healthcare services to those in need**.
