At Colorado Plains Medical Center,

we spent 2016 exploring ways to advance our mission of making the communities of Northeast Colorado healthier. And by focusing our efforts on creating a place where people choose to come for healthcare, physicians want to practice and employees want to work, our 65 year legacy of caring for our communities is stronger than ever.

Inviting the best physicians into our communities and supporting them is one of the most important drivers of our ability to offer the best possible healthcare to our community. During the past year, CPMC added **three new physicians** to our staff in pediatrics, urology and obstetrics and gynecology, and a **family nurse practitioner** in family medicine.

And while **delivering high quality patient care close to home** is the single most important contribution we make, there are many other ways we're making a positive impact in our communities.

In **creating excellent workplaces for our 345 employees**, we made **\$1,514,423 in capital improvements** in 2016, including the acquisition of a state-of-the-art, 64-slice CT scanner to better serve our trauma and stroke patients, and managed and distributed an **annual payroll of \$24,147,881**.

We are proud to take a **leadership role in our communities** and are committed to delivering needed healthcare to everyone, regardless of their ability to pay. In fact, in 2016 we donated **more than \$1.12 million in healthcare services to those in need**.
