And by focusing our efforts on creating a place where people choose to come for healthcare, physicians want to practice and employees want to work, our more than 30-year legacy of caring for our communities in Mason, Robertson, Fleming, Lewis, Bracken, Brown and Adams counties is stronger than ever.

Inviting the best physicians into our communities and supporting them is one of the most important drivers of our ability to offer the best possible healthcare to the region. During the past year, Meadowview added **three new physicians** in family medicine, orthopedics and obstetrics and gynecology.

In recognition of our ongoing efforts to provide high levels of patient safety and quality of care, we have been designated a **Duke LifePoint Quality Affiliate**. And while **delivering high quality patient care close to home** is the single most important contribution we make, there are many other ways we're making a positive impact in our communities.

In **creating excellent workplaces for our 405 employees**, we made **\$3,306,141 in capital improvements** in 2016, including the completion of our second cath lab, a Midmark Holter system for our cardiology practice, new analyzers for the lab department, a new X-ray imaging system for our orthopedics practice, a new camera security system and more; and we managed and distributed an **annual payroll of \$28,223,297**.
