At **Valley View Medical Center**, we spent 2016 exploring ways to advance our mission of making the Tri-State communities of Bullhead, Laughlin and Needles and surrounding areas healthier. And by focusing our efforts on creating a place where people choose to come for healthcare, physicians want to practice and employees want to work, our legacy of caring for our communities is stronger than ever.

**Inviting the best physicians into our communities and supporting them** is one of the most important drivers of our ability to offer the best possible healthcare to the region. During the past year, Valley View added **36 new physicians** in a number of service lines, including cardiology, gastroenterology, obstetrics and gynecology, pulmonology, physical medicine and rehabilitation, anesthesia, radiology and tele-radiology, emergency medicine, pathology and critical care/internal medicine.

And while **delivering high quality patient care close to home** is the single most important contribution we make, there are many other ways we're making a positive impact in our communities.

In **creating excellent workplaces for our 294 employees**, we made **\$451,033 in capital improvements** in 2016, including a new intra-aortic balloon pump for our cath lab, new surgical equipment and new equipment for our obstetrics department; and we managed and distributed an **annual payroll of \$24,029,357**.

We are proud to take a **leadership role in our communities** and are committed to delivering needed healthcare to everyone, regardless of their ability to pay. In fact, in 2016 we donated **more than \$2.69 million in healthcare services to those in need**.

We are also committed to **ensuring fiscal responsibility** – both at the hospital and in the community. In 2016, we paid a total of **\$627,286 in taxes**, as well as provided numerous sponsorships and donations to local organizations.
